# DOE Health, Safety and Security (HSS) Assist Visit – Scoping Team

  - HSS team assisted by McCallum-Turner Consultants
  - Several members of scoping team were here for DOE's 2007 ISM audit

- 1 hour of unsafe drinking water per month
- 2 unsafe landings per day at busy airport
- 50 dropped babies per day
- 116,000 lost pieces of mail per hour
- 20,000 incorrect drug prescriptions per year
- 22,000 checks deposited in wrong accounts per hour


